#### DISCUSSION:

- Committee was advised that Laura Haycraft has resigned. Applications have been received for her replacement and interviews will be held and selection made within the next two weeks.
- Billing for Storm water has been implemented for both Leon Valley water customers and SAWS customers. Fred reported that there are two no pays; Freyer on Huebner Road and Marcus on Bluebird, who will be contacted to explain that the storm water bill is payable even though they do not have water or sewer.
- Fred reported on activities that are now underway: An engineer has been retained to develop plans and specs to de-silt Zarzamora Creek, next to Christian Village apartments, and the drain from W. Seneca to Huebner Creek. Employee training has been conducted for all City employees on Storm Water. There will be additional street sweeping, four per year instead of two.
- The committee discussed the proposed ordinance on pet waste. The Development Department took the lead on this and presented this to the City Council. The ordinance was not passed due to many questions. Bob will meet with Kristy Flores to discuss this and reintroduce this to the Council.
- The committee discussed the proposed ordinance on yard waste. Minor changes were made and on a motion by Walter and second by Dave, the ordinance was approved with the noted corrections.
- The committee was asked to consider the SWMP and recommend additional ordinances that may be necessary to implement the program.
- Staff will prepare a three ring binder for each committee member with a copy of the permit and contact information of each committee member.
