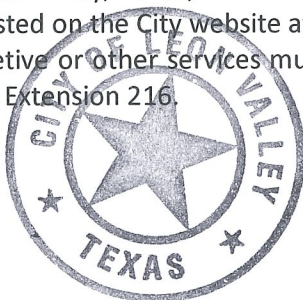


1. Welcome new members to committee.
