Police Chief Randall Wallace presented the proposed Fiscal Year 2016 Budget for the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District. Interim City Manager Hank Brummett agreed with Chief Wallace that the budgeted extra patrol officers would be a move in the right direction to improve the City's crime control and prevention.

A motion was made by Member Monica Alcocer and seconded by Board Member David Jordan, to postpone approval of this item to the September 29th Crime Control & Prevention Board of Directors Meeting. Board Member Alcocer felt strongly that this should have been presented prior to the General Fund Budget and not after.

Assistant Police Chief Ray Lacy wanted the City Council to know that he is a Crime Control Specialist and is bringing some new ideas to Leon Valley to improve the CoLV Crime Control & Prevention District.


