



W-2 Huebner Creek: Eckhart to Bandera Project

SAWS construction work on the W-2 Huebner Creek: Eckhart to Bandera Project will replace approximately 2 miles of 21 and 24-inch sewer mains along Huebner Creek between Eckhart Road and Bandera Road with larger sized sewer mains up to 42-inch diameter. This project is part of the work required by San Antonio's agreement with the EPA to address capacity constrained sewer infrastructure across the city.

When Will Work Occur?

Project construction is scheduled to begin in late 2021 and has an estimated duration of 15 months.

What to Expect

- ✓ Construction will impact Raymond Rimkus Park and Huebner Onion Natural Area.
 - The majority of the sewer installation in these areas will be via trenchless (tunneling) methods to reduce the impacts to the visiting public and minimize the removal of trees.
 - 95% of the trees along the sewer alignment are being saved.
- ✓ There will be increased truck traffic in the area.
- ✓ Traffic on Apple Green and Evers Road may be impacted.
- ✓ The design engineering firm is Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.
- ✓ Contractor for the Project is yet to be determined.
- ✓ The estimated construction cost is \$12.4 million.
