

**EARTHWISE LIVING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

FEBRUARY 28, 2018**

The Earthwise Living Committee of the City of Leon Valley, Texas met on the 28th day of February, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. at the Leon Valley Public Service Center, at 6427 Evers Road, Leon Valley, Texas, for the purpose of the following business, to-wit:

1. Call the City of Leon Valley Regular Earthwise Living Committee Meeting to Order and Determine a Quorum is Present.

The meeting was called to order at 5:45 PM. Present were Committee members Ealy, Hendricks, Burnside, Seiffert and Mayor Riley. Also present was Staff member Acuna. Absent were members Menard and Key.

2. Review and Approval of the February 7, 2018 Regular Earthwise Living Committee Meeting Minutes.

A motion to accept the minutes was made by Mayor Riley and seconded by member Hendricks. The motion was passed without objection with one correction in #2, Hedricks was corrected to Hendricks.

3. Discussion regarding Earthwise Living Day 2018.

Member Seiffert asked about the drop off location for the children and their instruments for the musical presentations and it was decided that the school buses could drive around the Community Center. Member Hendricks and member Mayor Riley offered to move the barricades to allow the buses to pass if there were not enough reserve officers available. Member Hendricks suggested having an aerial map of the location for the bus drivers. Member Seiffert stated that microphones would be needed for the presentations and further mentioned that she would check on the delivery of the risers.

Member Ealy updated the committee regarding the worm vendor, bikes, tents and the need to for a member to be available on Friday night for publicity spot on Channel 4.

A general discussion was had regarding the site plan and the need for microphones in both buildings and gifts for the teachers and students. Member Burnside suggested a green tote and Whole Earth coupon could be given to the teachers as their gifts and the children performing could receive coupons from Peter Piper Pizza. Member Seiffert stated that she would check on getting more coupons. Member Key was contacted by phone regarding the coupons she had collected and she mentioned having Peter Piper ice cream coupons, but due to the number of children performing, would ask for more coupons. Member Hendricks suggested that all volunteers should receive a gift and Member Mayor Riley suggested an Earthwise Living Volunteer Dinner.

A general discussion was had regarding only having two food vendors, Rockin Pescado and Kona Ice. Member Hendricks stated she contact Rockin Pescado to expand their menu to add another item(s) such as chicken on a stick. Member Ealy's caregiver volunteered to make pozole so there would be an additional food vendor.

Member Mayor Riley mentioned the need for petty cash for the apron sales. The Forest Oaks Garden Club members would be helping with the sale of those a prons, which will be sold for \$5.00 with tax included. She further mentioned that Spurs tickets were purchased as door prizes for the following games: March 11 and 16th. The cost was \$225 for 2 seats per game.

A discussion was had regarding set up for the event on Thursday and Friday. Member Ealy stated that she will be available on Friday from 3pm-7pm and Members Burnside and Hendricks will start set up at 12pm. Rainbow gardens will have plants ready for pick up on Friday and banners will be hung from the ceiling for the presentations.

Staff member Acuna mentioned that vendor forms had not been received from the Leon Valley Historical Society, San Antonio Aquarium or the Doseum.

Member Hendricks moved to adjourn the meeting and the motion was seconded by member Seiffert. The meeting was adjourned without objection at 7:28 pm.
