

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEON VALLEY TEXAS, CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE BILLING AT A RATE OF 7% COMMISSION, PAYABLE TO EMERGICON MEDICAL BILLING SERVICE, FOR EMS BILLING SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Division of the Fire Department uses a Contractor, Intermedix Billing, to perform billing services; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Intermedix has expired but the term has been extended by mutual agreement; and

WHEREAS, Requests for Proposal (RFP) for EMS Billing Services was advertised beginning June 19, 2016, and six vendors responded by the July 12th, 2016 deadline; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by Emergicon Medical Billing Service at a rate of 7% commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEON VALLEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The lowest responsive bid of Emergicon Medical Billing Service at a rate of 7% commission for EMS Billing Services for the Fire Department Emergency Medical Services program is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates or the expiration of ninety (90) days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first.

Section 2. A construction contract is hereby awarded to Emergicon Medical Billing Service.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by four or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
