



**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
LEON VALLEY POOL ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Meeting of the Leon Valley Pool Advisory Committee at 5:00 PM, on Monday, March 7, 2018, at Leon Valley City Hall (Conference Room), 6400 El Verde Road, Leon Valley, Texas.

I. Call to order

The meeting was called to order at 5:04 p.m.

II. Approval of Minutes for February 12, 2018

The minutes were reviewed by the Committee. Mr. Proffitt moved to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Ms. Carolyn Diaz.

III. Information / Reports

Town Hall Meeting Follow Up – David Dimaline provided a report on citizen input from the Town Hall Meeting regarding the pools.

- A suggestion was made to plant more trees at both pools.
- Construct a new Party Room at the Community Pool.
- Make improvements to the web site showcasing both pools and provide more information for pool parties and tennis courts.

Discussion of 2018 Pool Season – Mr. Rob Dowie, SELA Aquatics was present and a general discussion of the pool season followed. Mr. Dowie provided details on the concession list, and briefed the Committee on the offerings for the 2018 swim season. The Committee mentioned that the previous year concession snacks were limited. Mr. Dowie explained that the 2018 menu will include more varieties of snacks and drinks. The pools will also rotate closing

Monday and Tuesday so instead of both pools being closed the same day, this year one pool will be open on Monday and Tuesday. Both of these items were recommended by the Pool Advisory Committee. The Committee asked Mr. Dowie about pool fees, and he said at this time he did not know what the fees would be, but the goal is to try and maintain a similar fee for season passes. He advised the Committee that SELA would also offer monthly payments if members did not wish to pay for the entire season in one payment. Mr. Larry Proffitt mentioned the importance of holding an open house event prior to the pools opening. Mr. Dowie said that SELA would plan an open house event the first weekend and perhaps open for free at no charge.

IV. Adjournment

Ms. Baldrige moved to adjourn. The motion was Seconded by Mr. Proffitt, and the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:38 p.m.
