#### Town Hall Meeting Presentations and Topics


Mayor Riley introduced the meeting topics to be discussed and briefly described how the Town Hall Meeting would be conducted.

Mayor Riley summarized the City of Leon Valley's progress towards reaching the City's vision statements and the underlying objectives. She talked about the City's advancement towards meeting its commitment to El Verde 2020, the City's plan for environmentally protective and responsive program initiatives. Mayor Riley covered each of the City of Leon Valley's mission statements, the seven strategic goals, and celebration of successes. Meeting topics and presentations include: Celebration of Successes, Street Repair Projects, Street Maintenance Tax Renewal, Town Center Project, and the Strategic Vision relating to Police and Fire Departments, Library Expansion Project Updates, City Personnel, Opportunities for Bandera Corridor, City Project Funding Mechanisms, Bexar County Flood Control Project Update, and Town Hall Meeting Wrap-up.
