

**SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE CITY OF LEON VALLEY, TEXAS,
MARCH 16, 2011**

The City Council of the City of Leon Valley, Texas, met on the 16th day of March, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at the Leon Valley City Council Chambers, at 6400 El Verde Road, Leon Valley, Texas, for the purpose of the following business, to-wit:

Call to Order, and Determine a Quorum is Present.

Mayor Riley called the Special City Council Meeting to order at 5:54 p.m. and asked that the minutes reflect that the following City Council Members were present: Garcia, Reyna, Baldrige, Dean, and Nelson.

City staff in attendance: Interim City Manager Brummett and City Secretary Willman.

Executive Session in Accordance with Texas Government Code:

- A. The Leon Valley City Council convened in Executive Session Pursuant to Section 551.074, Personnel Matters, to conduct Candidate interviews for the position of City Manager.

- B. The Leon Valley City Council reconvened into open session at 7:04 p.m. to consider any possible actions as appropriate from Executive Session regarding Personnel Matters and the Employment of a City Manager.


Motion by Councilman Reyna and second by Councilman Dean, to authorize the Mayor to negotiate an employment agreement with Mr. Manuel "Manny" Longoria, Jr., as City Manager of the City of Leon Valley pursuant to the terms contained in Exhibit A, Agreement, and subject to proper recognition of the details of the date of employment to be determined after the City of Leon Valley attorneys have approved it. Voting Aye: Garcia, Reyna, Baldrige, Dean, and Nelson. Voting Nay: None. Mayor Riley announced the motion carried.

The Mayor announced a short recess at 7:07 p.m. during which she and Mr. Longoria would confer on the details of the employment agreement as authorized by the City Council.

Mayor Riley and Mr. Longoria rejoined the City Council at 7:12 p.m. following a short recess. Mayor Riley announced that she and Mr. Longoria made the following changes to the employment agreement: crossed through the contract effective date to be determined once Mr. Longoria speaks with the Mayor of Shavano Park, with no later than a 60 day maximum start date of May 16, and on page 3, # 11, "Employer will pay a monthly vehicle allowance to Employee at the rate of \$375, and \$288 monthly health insurance premium, provided the City Manager opts out of the City of Leon Valley's Health Insurance."
