City staff in attendance: Library Director Trent and City Secretary Willman.


The Forum was moderated by Evelyn Bonavita and Mary Anne Kramer served as the timekeeper; both members of the League of Women Voters.

City Council Candidates spoke on a variety of topics including economic development, infrastructure, the City’s El Verde by 2020 initiative, greater support for the City’s Police and Fire personnel including the possible use of the remaining 1/8 cent on the sales tax rate, term limits, management of the Natural Area, Tax Increment Financing (TIFs) to makeup revenue for City businesses, ways to improve traffic on Bandera Road, attendance at City Council Meetings, City safety, are we as safe as we used to be.


City Council Candidates made closing statements including answering what their number one priority is and would be if elected.
