TEXAS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2011


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEON


2. This ordinance shall become effective on and after it's passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.

SUBJECT: A Request to Consider Amending City Manager Lanny Lambert's Contract in Compliance with Current Departing Employee Policy to Authorize Payment of Accrued Personal Leave of 272 Hours and Related Budget Adjustments.

PURPOSE

As City Manager Lanny Lambert is anticipating the Leon Valley City Council's acceptance of his formal resignation effective January 7, 2011, close-of-business, he is requesting that the City Council consider amending his contract to allow the payment of 272 hours of personal leave which would allow for payment of hours earned recognizing his contributions to the City of Leon Valley as with any other City employee.

A budget adjustment, if authorized by the City Council, would be as follows:
