

SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS FOR THE POLICE FORFEITURE TRUST FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF MULTI-PURPOSE IMMOBILIZATION DEVICES

**PURPOSE**

In December 2009 the Police Department purchased six Stinger S-200AT devices. Since that time Stinger was found to have patent violations on their S-200AT device. Stinger also filed for bankruptcy and the assets/liabilities were purchased by Karbon Arms. Karbon Arms has since designed and patented their Multi-Purpose Immobilization Device (MPID).

One of the Stinger devices had issues covered under the warranty and this device was replaced with a Karbon Arms MPID.

The Police Department has received notification from the company who brought the patent violation claims against Stinger that the continued use of the Stinger S-200AT is in violation of Federal Law.

The Leon Valley Police Department would like to purchase five Karbon Arms MPID's.

The Devices cost \$600 each, with the camera/audio system installed. We will also need one docking station which costs \$120.

Purchase five Karbon Arms MPID's and Docking Station \$ 3,120
