'New' Leon Valley is on the move

A couple of facelifts are in the future for at least two Leon Valley shopping centers, Economic Development Director Rose Ryan says.

Crossway Center, at Poss and Bandera, owned by Greenblum Partners LLC, is slated for a do over that could include a clock tower, but Ryan says she has no timeline on the front façade improvements as yet.

Leon Creek Shopping Center, located at Bandera and Huebner, received a partial facelift when Planet Fitness moved into the center last year, which also included front renovations to Bandera Bowl.

"Now, the owners are planning a facelift for the entire area in front of Planet Fitness and Bandera Bowl," said Ryan.
