

**Proposed Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District Temporary Board of Directors**

**Resolution 2013R-08-20-02**

**A resolution ordering a Special Election to be held on November 5, 2013 in the City of Leon Valley for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition relating to the creation of the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District and the adoption of a local sales and use tax at a rate of one-eighth of one percent pursuant to Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code**

- WHEREAS, the Leon Valley City Council proposed the creation of the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District and appointed a seven member temporary Board of Directors at its July 9, 2013 meeting; and
- WHEREAS, the temporary Board of Directors has coordinated its efforts with local law enforcement officials and agencies to assist in the formulation of a two year Crime Control Plan and two-year Budget Plan;
- WHEREAS, the temporary Board of Directors conducted a public hearing on August 20 2013 on the proposed two-year crime control plan and two year budget plan pursuant to Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code;
- WHEREAS, the temporary Board of Directors thereafter adopted a two-year Crime Control Plan and two-year Budget Plan at its August 20, 2013 meeting;
- WHEREAS, the temporary Board of Directors submitted the two-year Crime Control Plan and two-year Budget Plan at the August 20, 2013 meeting of the Leon Valley City Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District Temporary Board of Directors hereby orders an election on the creation of the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District and the imposition of a proposed sales and use tax **at the rate of one-eighth of one percent** to be held in the City of Leon Valley on the November 5, 2013 uniform election date;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TEMPORARY DIRECTORS OF THE PROPOSED LEON VALLEY CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF LEON VALLEY, TEXAS:

1.

That an election be held in the City of Leon Valley, Texas, on Tuesday, the 5th day of November, 2013, (hereinafter the "Election") for the purpose of submitting to the voters a proposition relating to the creation of the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District

dedicated to crime reduction programs and the adoption of proposed local sales and use tax at a **rate of one-eighth of one percent** for the financing and operation of the District pursuant to Chapter 363 of the Texas Local Government Code.

**The Election shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on November 5, 2013.**

2.

The approved budget plan and crime control plan for the proposed Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District is summarized as follows:

### **Two-Year Crime Control Plan**

#### Community Policing

Focus our Community Resource Officer and Criminal Investigation Detectives to participate in Neighborhood Watch, Crime Awareness activities, and general crime prevention activities within the City of Leon Valley.

The effectiveness of this will be measured by the number of meetings and interactions with our Citizens in regards to crime prevention. The Department is planning on having a monthly meeting to discuss any crime related activities within the City of Leon Valley. The Detectives will also document and track any interactions they have with crime victims or the general public in regards to crime prevention.

#### Investing in our Police

Allocation of funding for the purchase of equipment utilized by the individual Officers.

Allocation of funding to train Officers for advanced certifications awarded by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Education and Standards.

Allocation of funding for overtime pay to compensate Officers for working above their scheduled 80 hour pay period.

The effectiveness of these items will be measured by the equipment purchased, the number of training hours completed, and the number of overtime hours invested into Community Policing.

The current sales tax for the City of Leon Valley is 0.0812500. The proposed local sales and use tax at a rate of one-eighth of one percent is equal to 0.0012500 making the total sales tax for the City of Leon Valley 0.0825000 if the proposition is approved by the voters of Leon Valley.

3.

At the election, the following proposition shall be submitted and shall be printed on the ballots to permit voters to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the proposition:

**"The creation of the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District dedicated to crime reduction programs and the adoption of a proposed local sales and use tax at a rate of one-eighth of one percent."**

4.

Said Election shall be held under the provisions of Ordinances of the City of Leon Valley, the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and the Voting Rights Act of 1965, and amendments thereof, insofar as same may be applicable.

5.

This resolution shall constitute the Order of the Election.

6.

The following places are designated as polling places for the November 5, 2013, special election. The polling place locations shall be published in the Notice of Election as required by law.

Jacquelyn Callanen is hereby appointed as Early Voting Clerk for the Election. Early voting by mail shall be conducted in conformance with the requirements of the Code. The main early voting polling place is hereby designated to be the Bexar County Elections Center, 203 West Nueva, San Antonio, Texas 78207. Ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be sent to: Jacquelyn Callanen, Early Voting Clerk, 203 West Nueva, San Antonio, Texas 78207-4045.

8.

Early voting by personal appearance in the Election will begin October 23, 2013 and continue through November 1, 2013, with the voting dates and hours as follows:

October 21–25, 201, Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

October 26, 2013, Saturday 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

October 27, 2013, Sunday 12:00 noon – 6:00 p.m.

October 28–November 1, 2013, Monday - Friday 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.

9.

Early voting in person in the Election shall be conducted by the Early Voting Clerk at the following Leon Valley location:

A. Leon Valley Community Center, 6421 Evers Road, Leon Valley, Texas 78240

B. In addition to the early voting polling location located within the City, Leon Valley voters may vote at all early voting polling locations maintained by Bexar County throughout the County.


The City Secretary shall cause official ballots to be prepared in the form of the ballot first above prescribed, being in both English and Spanish, and shall furnish election officials said ballots, in such form, together with any other forms or blanks, in accordance with the Ordinances of the City

of Leon Valley, Texas, the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas and the Voting Rights Act of 1965, and any amendments thereto, insofar as same are applicable.



A substantial copy of this election order shall be published in a newspaper with general circulation in the proposed district once a week for two consecutive weeks with the first publication to occur prior to the 35th day before the Election. Further notice of the Election shall be given by posting a notice in both English and Spanish at the City Hall on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council not less than twenty-one (21) days prior to the date of the Election, and by publication of said notice at least once in a newspaper of general circulation not earlier than the 30th day nor later than the 10th day before the date of the Election. Said notices shall be posted in both English and Spanish.

PRESENTED AND PASSED on this the 20 day of August, 2013, by a vote of 6 ayes and 0 nays at a meeting of the temporary directors of the Leon Valley Crime Control and Prevention District of the City of Leon Valley, Texas.


