The Assistant Planning and Zoning Director will also be the primary staff member responsible for processing zoning changes, variances, and plat requests. Secondary responsibilities of the Assistant Planning and Zoning Director will include assisting the Director with long-range planning, general department administration, and the supervision of permitting Staff. Secondary responsibilities will also include the intake of building permit requests when needed.
