



SWIMMING POOL RULES

In order to assure that everyone has safe, clean fun, and fantastic summer swim, the following rules will be strictly enforced:

- All guests will be expected to follow all the pool rules
- A responsible adult (person aged 18 or older) must accompany children under 12 years of age at all times
 - Parents will be called to pickup a child who is too young to be at the pool by themselves or who does not follow the rules
- Proper swimwear is required – cutoff shorts and undergarments are not allowed in the pool
- No food, drinks, alcohol, gum, or tobacco are allowed in the pool
- Smoking is not permitted in the enclosed pool area
- Glass containers are not allowed on the pool premises
- Diving allowed only from diving board
- The baby pool is for children ages 6 and under
 - All children using the baby pool must be directly supervised by an adult who must remain beside the pool at all times
- No animals in the pool or on the deck (except service animals)
- No running, horseplay, fighting, dangerous conduct, or loud noise
- No foul or vulgar language
- Guests are expected to abide by the POOL RULES at all times
- No Diapers, with the exception of swim diapers (guests are responsible for proper swim diaper disposal)
- Lifeguards are responsible for enforcement of the pool rules and may remove anyone from pool premises for any violation of the pool rules
- Picnic tables and barbecue pits are available on a first come – first serve basis
- Lawn chairs and ice chests are allowed
- Lifeguards must be notified immediately of all injuries and an injury report must be written – these forms will be made available at the concession stand
- For serious injury or life threatening emergency assistance **CALL 911**. The emergency phone is located at the concession stand area.
