Project	Description	Notes / Status
CDBG Castle Estates Sewer Main Project (Sovrex, LLC)	Install 1,576 feet of 8" sewer main, 7 manholes, sewer laterals, and two-way cleanouts and asphalt repairs.	Neighborhood Project Meeting held on June 17th. Contractor began construction on 7/13. Project is 75% complete.
TxDOT Hike and Bike Trail Phase II (Presidio Contracting, LLC)	Construct a 10' trail along the Huebner Creek Onion Natural Area and Rimkus Park (Bandera Rd. to Evers Rd.) to include a 70 ft. span prefabricated pedestrian bridge.	Neighborhood Project Meeting held on June 4th. Contractor began construction on 7/6. Approximately 270 feet of trail has been poured.
ARPA El Verde Rd. Water and Drainage Improvements Project (D&D Contractors, Inc.)	Replace 1,202 feet of AC water main with PVC, new water services, fire hydrants, and appurtenances. Drainage improvements include triangular bar ditches, with 242 LF of 18" RCP, Type II SET's at culvert inlets, asphalt trench restoration, and driveway restoration.	Asphalt repairs are completed. Remaining work includes final cleanup and project closeout.

Additional Public Works Activities

- Staff will be working on curb and asphalt replacement at 6631 Huebner Rd.
- Crew will be working at 6630 Huebner Rd.: 10 feet of curb removed along with asphalt repairs.

- Crew will be removing and replacing a section of broken concrete step outside of the Poppy's Café doorway entrance. Staff will continue mowing Evers Rd. this week, along with trimming and edging.
- Staff will continue to address low-hanging tree limbs and trim trees in Rimkus Park, Old Mill Park, and the Silo Park.
- Building maintenance staff will be addressing a leaking refrigerator inside Poppy's Café.
- Staff will be repairing a sewer backup and clogged drains at the main restroom in Rimkus Park.
- Crews completed mowing and trimming the drainage from the Ridge into the detention pond area.
- Crews will be addressing the El Verde Rd. drainage crossing at Huebner Creek.
- Crews completed their fit test last week for emergency breathing apparatus equipment.
- Crews will be finalizing work on the Fire Department fire hydrant maintenance list, 90% complete.
- Staff continue with meter reading.
- Staff will complete dead-end flushing and monthly water samples.
- Staff met with a contractor last week, to discuss a quote for valve and fire hydrant installations.
- Second PD unit in for service to prepare for auction.
- Additional lawnmowers in for service – waiting on parts.
- Two weed eaters in for service.
- Repair needed on a faucet at fleet car wash.
- Staff has completed the sidewalk replacement on Huebner Rd. that sank between Weathered Post and Timberhill.
- Crews removed the old asphalt and prepared the subgrade for new asphalt.
- New asphalt will be applied this week on Huebner Rd.
- An asphalt repair was made on the edge of Pavement along Thunderbird.
- Staff continue mowing detention pond areas and creeks this week.
- Staff will be addressing low-hanging tree limbs and trimming trees in the parks.
- The Natural Area trails were trimmed.
- Building maintenance staff will be addressing service requests at City Hall, PD and the Conference Center.
- School Zone flashers were serviced and re-programmed for the upcoming school year.
- Crews repaired a main break on Grass Hill Dr. and William Rancher.
- Crews will be finalizing work on the FD fire hydrant maintenance list.
- Annual tank inspections per the TCEQ have been completed.
- Staff will begin reading water meters on the commercial route this week.
- Repaired the walk-behind skid steer – changed fuel line.
- Completed repairs on the Construction truck – replaced AC system.
- Preparing a PD vehicle for auction and a Public Works vehicle.
- Changing out tires on PD vehicle.
- Performing repairs and PM on several weed eaters.

PW GRANTS

- Staff submitted a CDBG grant application to replace the Sewer Main in the alley behind Mike Nesmith.
- Staff applied for a grant from the AAMPO for the Hike & Bike Trail Segment 3. The trail will connect at Evers Road and align with Huebner Creek up to Balky at the northern city limits line and connect to the City of San Antonio's trail system, which is already in engineering and design.
- The city was awarded a 50/50 matching grant in the amount of \$725,852 from the Texas Parks & Wildlife for the Forest Oaks Pool Renovation. Total project cost is estimated at \$1,451,704. TPWD staff conducted a site visit. We anticipate receiving the grant Agreement from TPWD in October. The grant contract period will be four years from the grant Agreement date. Project scope includes: replaster existing swimming pool, install new equipment, demolish baby pool and sidewalks/pool decking around the pool, demolish clubhouse and restrooms, install new sidewalks/pool decking, new restrooms, mechanical building, storage room, lifeguard office, covered pavilion and shade canopies, new fencing, and new ADA chair lift.
- The city was awarded a grant for a Hike & Bike Trails Connectivity Master Plan from the AAMPO. This grant will pay \$230,000 for a planning document for the city's trail and shared path system. Staff attended a TxDOT meeting to discuss the grant timeline. The project kickoff meeting was held, and we are completing the TA Project Initiation & Development Checklist. TxDOT will then develop the Advanced Funding Agreement (5 mos.) The consultant procurement process can then begin.
