Future General Elections - 2024 General Election

The regular City election (*General Election*) shall be held annually on the uniform election date in May, or at such other times as may be specified by State Law, at which time officers will be elected to fill those offices which become vacant that year. <u>Please visit this link for more information related to election dates</u>.

The May 04, 2024, General Election, to elect City Council members to Place 2, Place 4 and to the Office of Mayor, will be held at the Leon Valley Conference Center, located at 6421 Evers Road, Leon Valley, TX 78238. Filing for a place on the ballot is set by state statute and will run from January 17, 2024 to February 16, 2024. Please visit this link to view more information related to important election dates.

Filing requirements are per state statute, and are available for viewing here, as well as in the Leon Valley's Charter, Article III. The City Council and Mayor § 3.03 Qualifications.

- **In person**, with the City Secretary's office at City Hall located at 6400 El Verde Road, Leon Valley, TX 78238 (210) 684-1391 ext. 216.
- **By mail**, to Leon Valley City Hall, Attention: Office of the City Secretary, 6400 El Verde Road, Leon Valley, TX 78238. An application submitted by mail is considered to be filed at the time of its receipt by the proper filing authority. (Sec. 143.007(b); 144.005(b)); or
- By fax or e-mail A signed, sworn, scanned candidate application (and petition, if applicable) may be submitted by fax to the attention of the Office of the City Secretary at 210-684-4476; or by e-mail at s.pass@leonvalleytexas.gov if there is no filing fee, [the City of Leon Valley does not charge a filing fee]. An application must be notarized prior to filing via fax or email.
