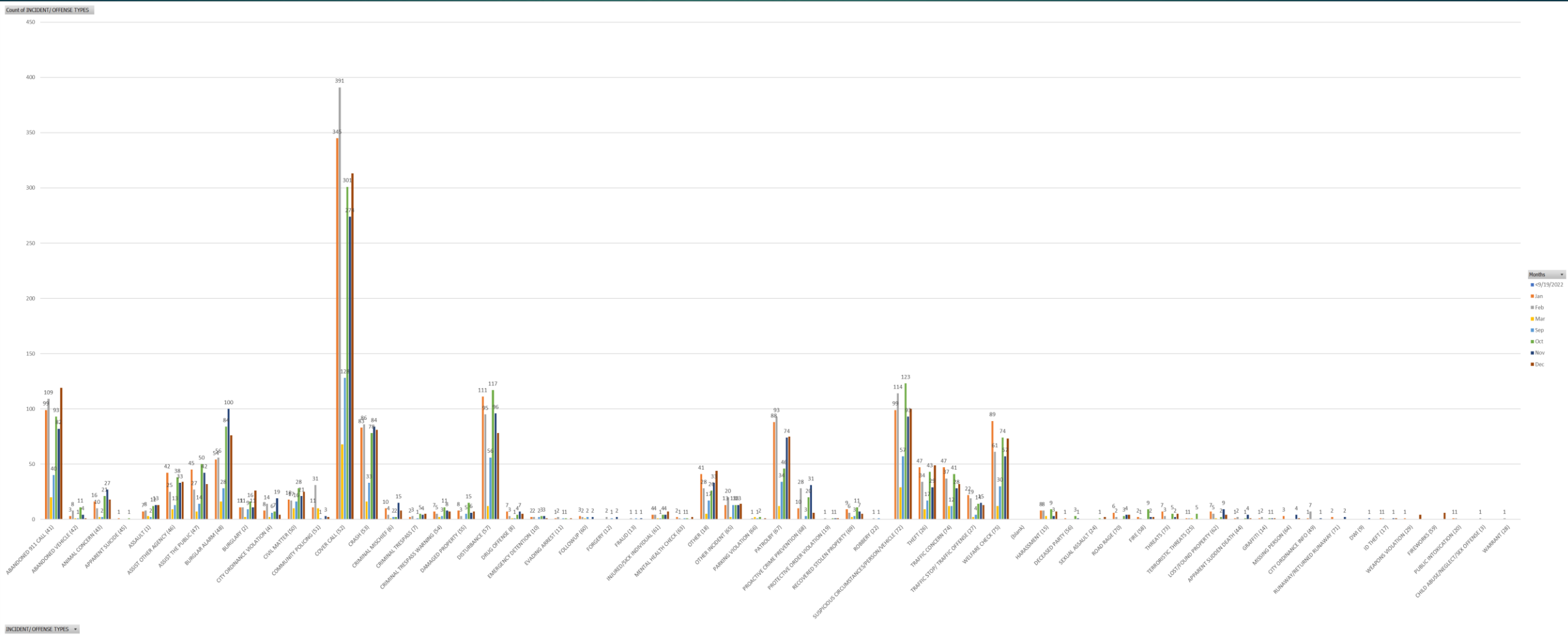

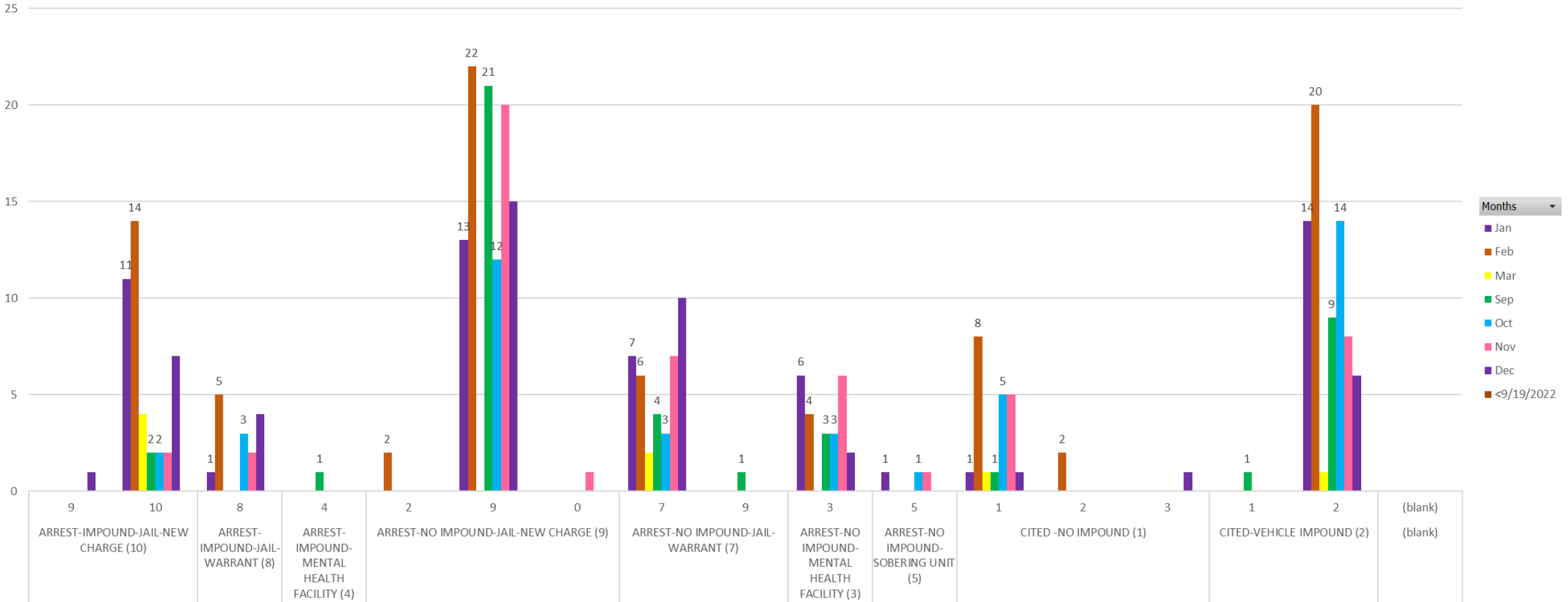
Police Calls by Type

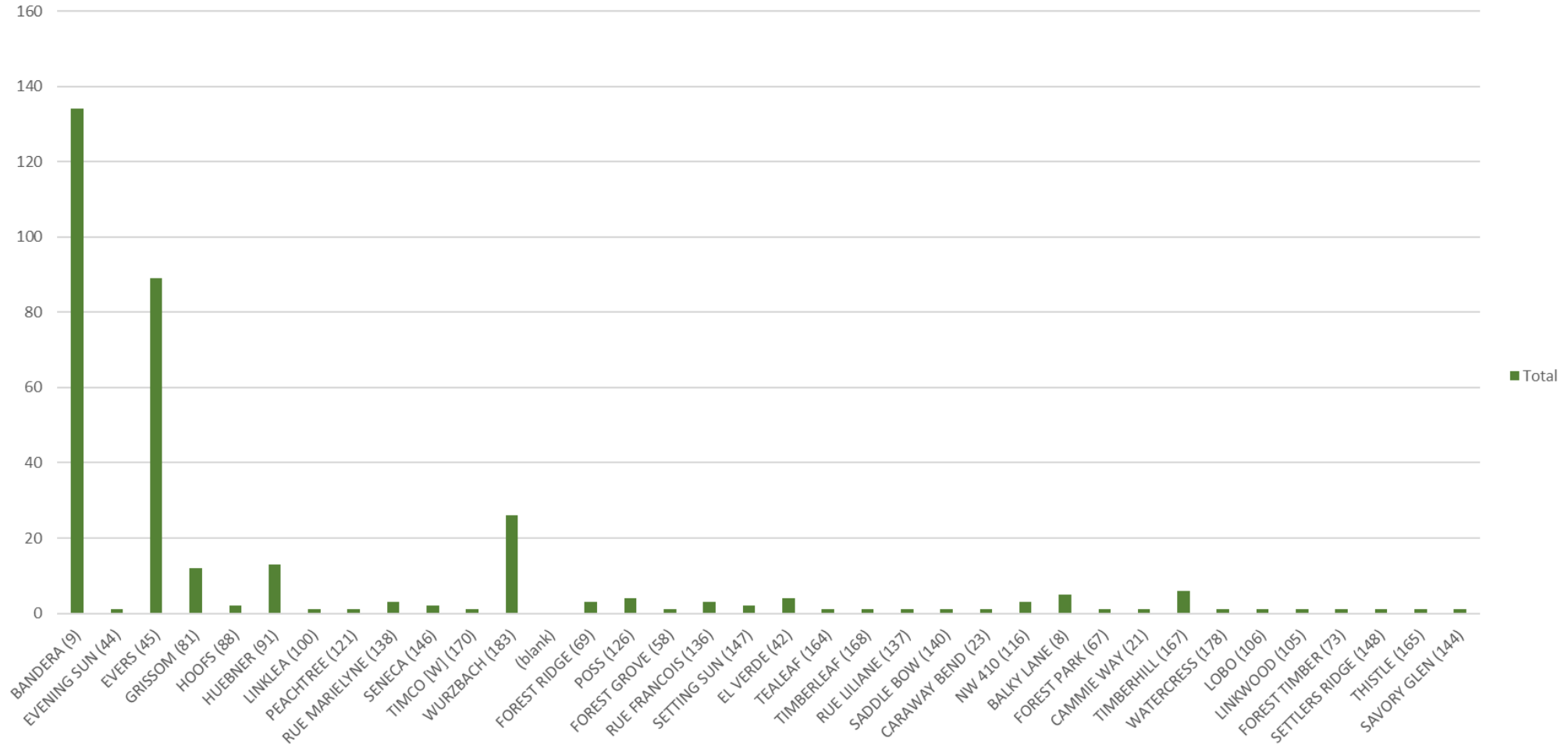

Arrest by Steet

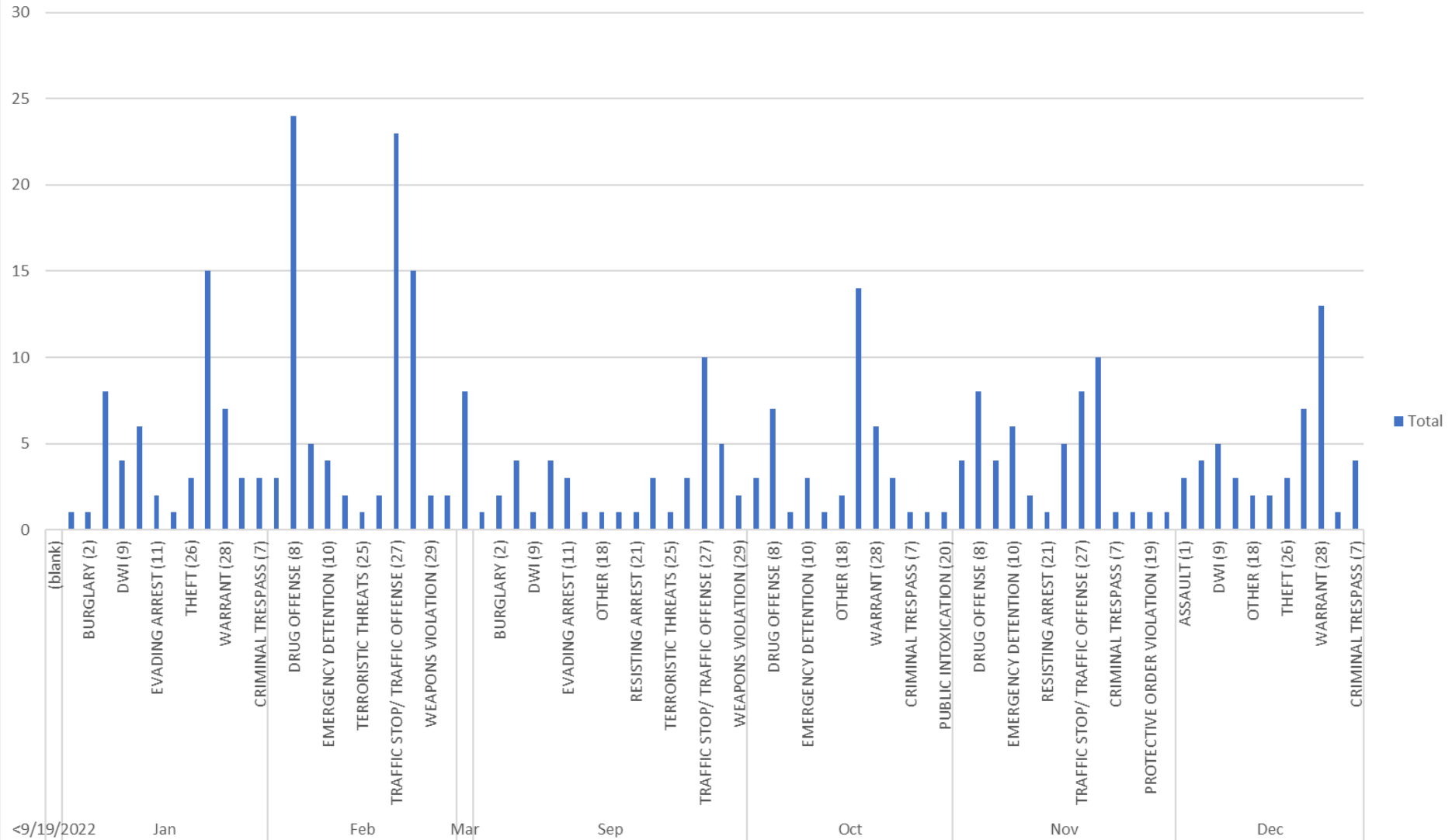

Arrest by Type



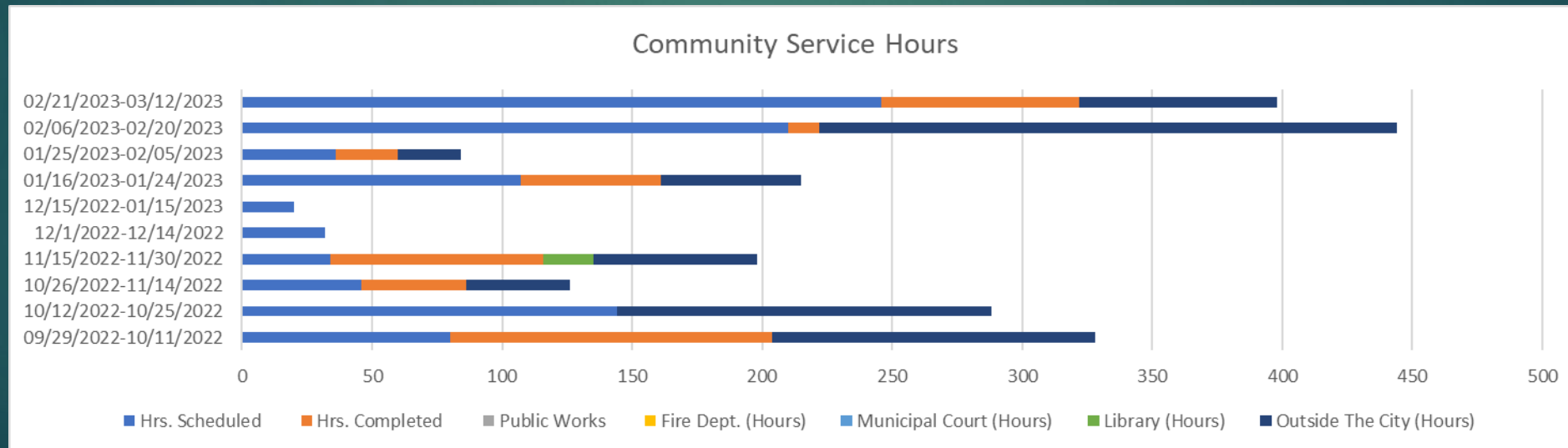

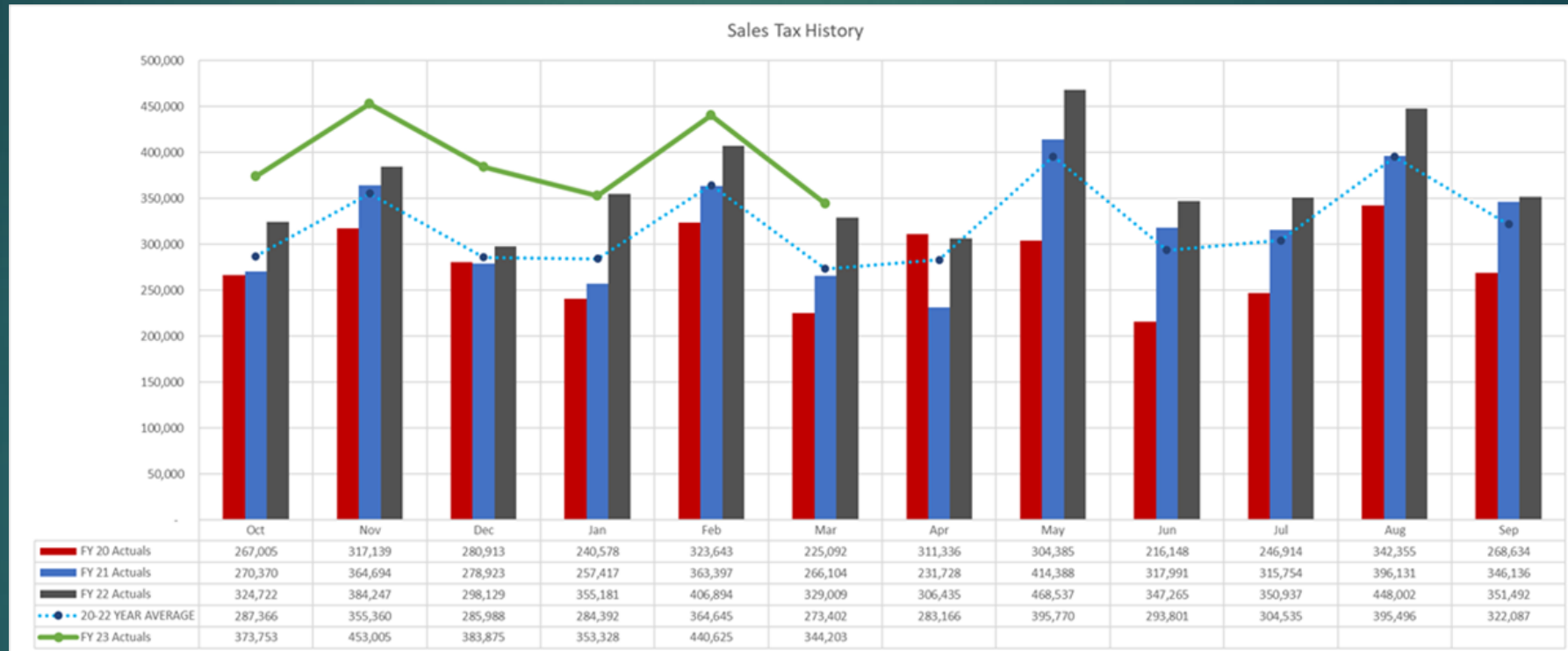
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

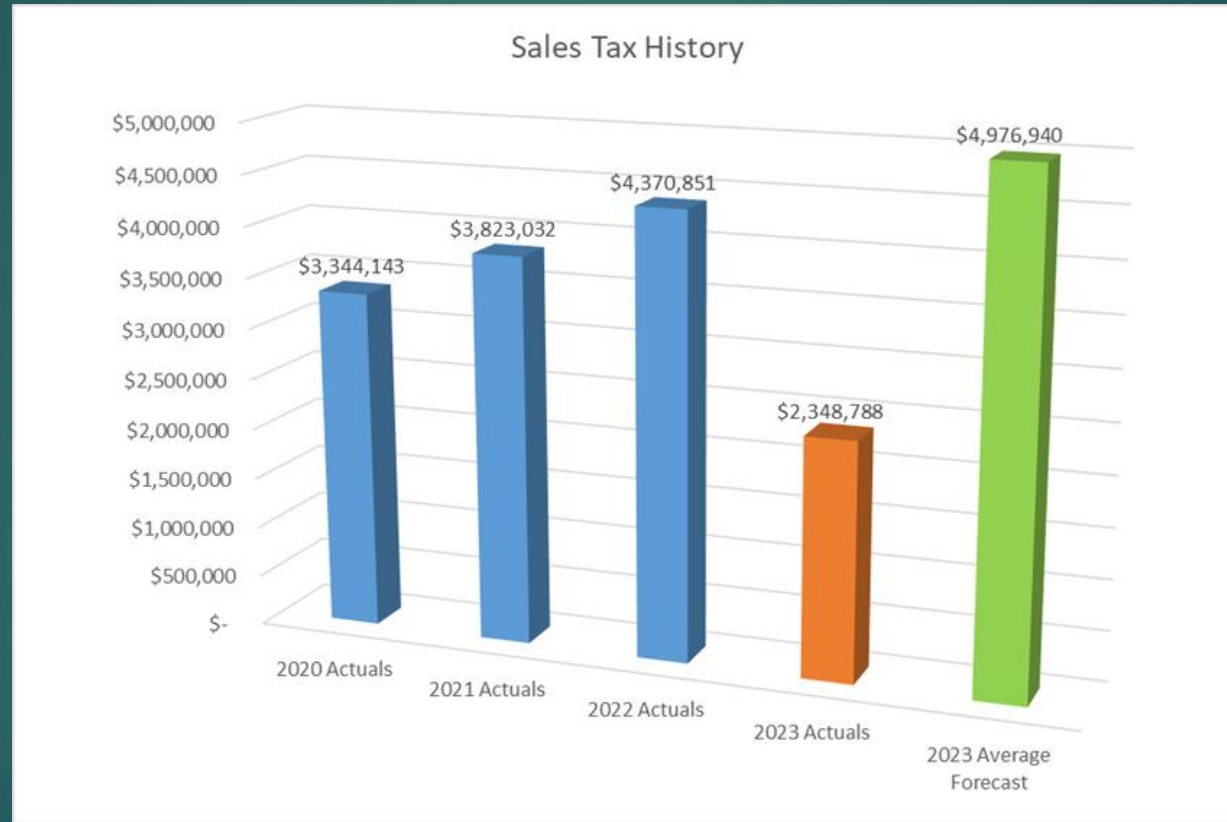
The city collected \$344,203 for January 2023. This amount continues the trend of above average collections. This amount is \$15,193 or 4.61% higher compared to the same month last year. The collection for this month is also higher than the 3-year average of \$273,402.

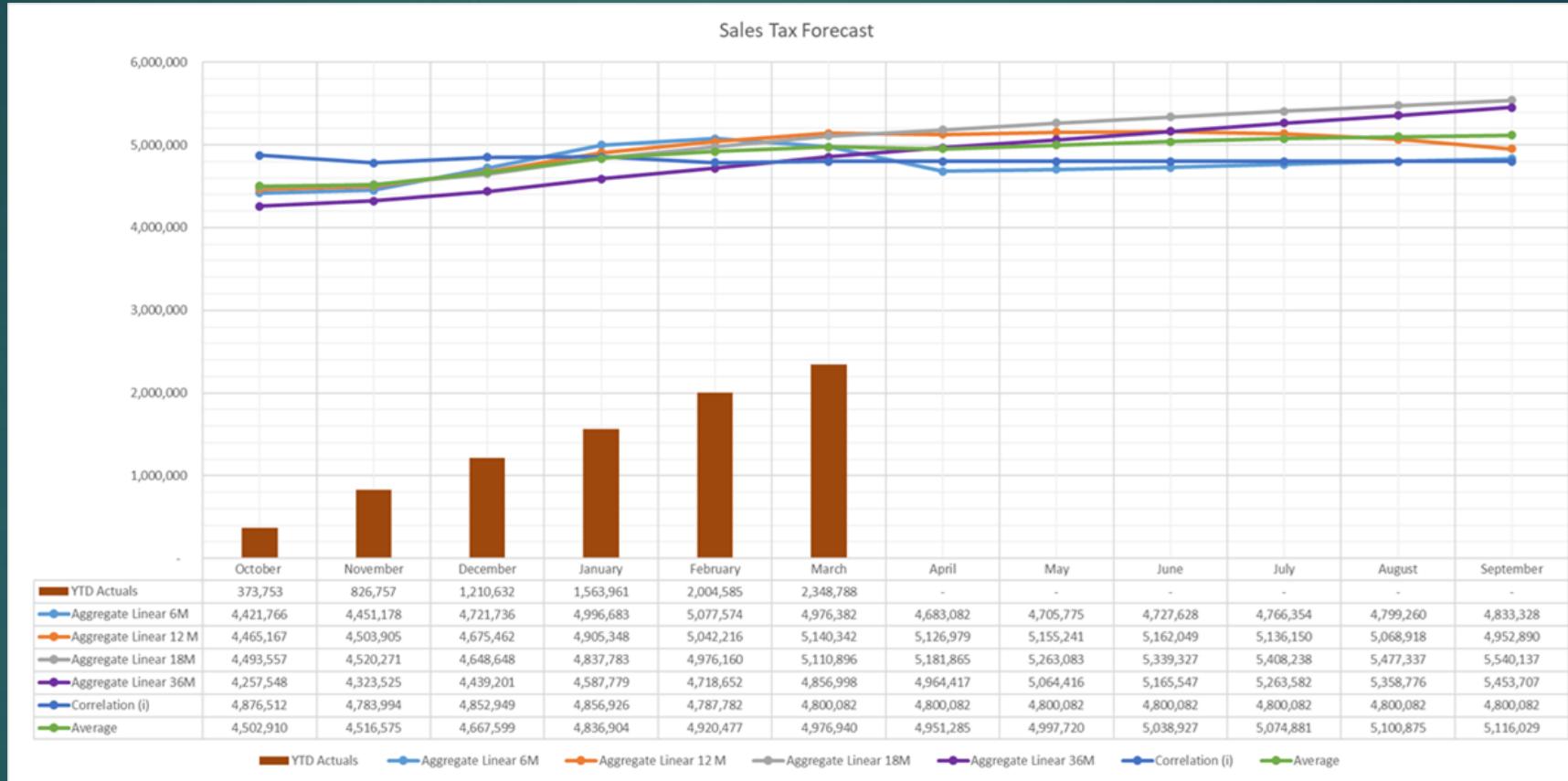

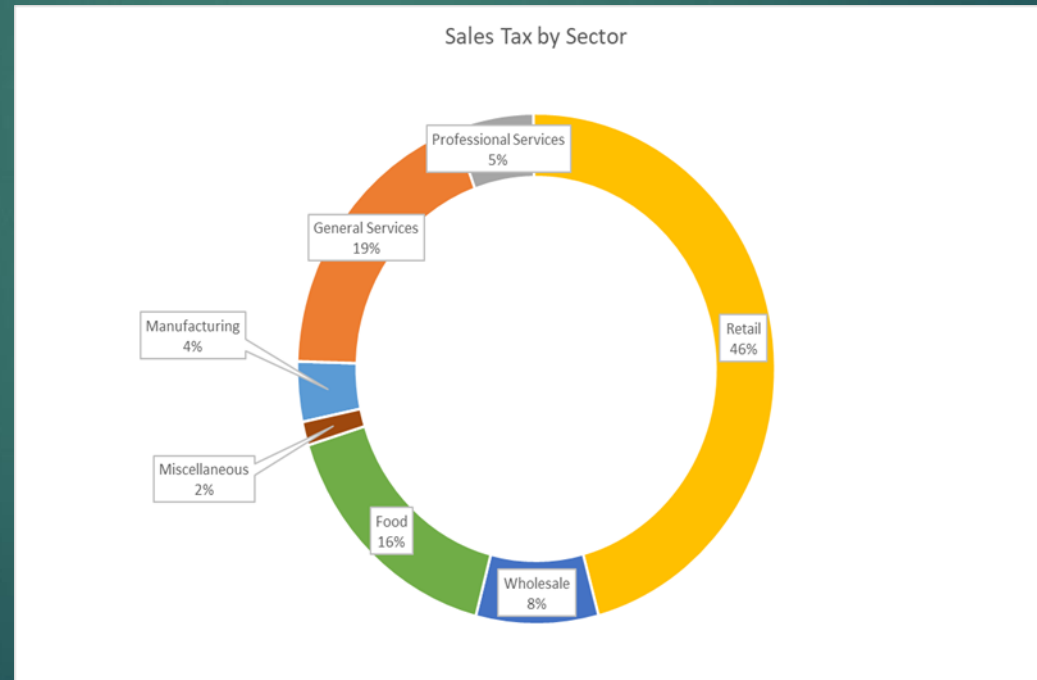
