

# Capital Improvement Project Summary: Wurzbach GST No. 1 Replacement

# **About the Project**

The Wurzbach Pump Station, located at the corner of Wurzbach Road and Evers Road on San Antonio's Northwest Side, is home to a 7.5-million-gallon water storage tank that has significant internal corrosion. Because of its condition, the tank no longer meets current safety and quality standards set by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), American Water Works Association (AWWA), and OSHA. To ensure reliable water service and protect public health, the tank will be replaced. This proactive investment will help avoid costly future repairs and extend the life of the facility.

### When Will Work Occur?

The project is expected to go out for bids in August 2025, with construction anticipated to begin in September 2025.

## What to Expect

- •The existing 7.5-million-gallon ground storage tank will be safely taken down.
- •A new 7.5-million-gallon tank will be built in its place, along with related components like an overflow structure, inlet and outlet piping, valves, and site grading.
- •The project also includes some electrical work and updates to the system that helps monitor and control the tank's operation.
