ORDINANCE

Discussion and Possible Action on an Ordinance Extending a Public Health Emergency Declaration Regarding Precautionary Measures in Reference to the COVID-19 Virus. (Members of the public may listen to the deliberations on this item; and, provide comments and testimony in the Public Comments part of the presentation, by calling 210-684-1391 at 5:30 p.m.) (M&C # 2020-03-18-01 K. Kuenstler)

City Attorney Habib Erkan presented the Bexar County Declaration.

There was a lengthy discussion followed by the following action:

With the exception of Councilor Matthew Hodde, there was a consensus to close the park restrooms for thirty (30) days.

There was a consensus to waive all water disconnections for the next thirty (30) days.

There was a consensus to close all bars and restaurants but to allow restaurants to have "take-out" dining only.

Fines were discussed with all agreeing that there would be a minimum of a \$250 and a maximum of \$500 fine on the first offense; subsequent offenses with a minimum of \$500 and a maximum of \$1000; third offense would be revocation of certificate of occupancy. Councilor Bradshaw did not agree with the revocation of the certificate of occupancy.

There was a consensus that funeral homes should keep people at arm's length from one another.

There was a consensus to close gyms, bowling alleys, and skating rinks.

City Manager Kelly Kuenstler read e-mails submitted by: Sarah Smart; and John Valenzuela

A motion was made by Councilor Catherine Rodriguez to accept the Emergency Ordinance with modifications

Mayor Riley proceeded with a roll call vote to which the City Council replied: Councilor Donna Charles - Aye; Councilor Catherine Rodriguez - Aye; Councilor Monica Alcocer - Aye; Councilor Monica Alcocer - Aye; and Councilor Will Bradshaw - Aye.

Mayor Riley announced the motion carried.
