

## JOB ANNOUNCEMENT POLICE PATROL OFFICER

Responsible for responding to emergency calls, patrolling, assisting in crime prevention, training of police personnel, providing enforcement, providing traffic control, and conducting investigations; under the laws of the City, State, and the United States; carry out special assignments in the field of police work; provide reports of assignments and/or do related work as required.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Minimum of a Basic Peace Officer certification is required to apply.
- Must fill out Personal History Statement and include it with the application.
- Must be able to pass physical fitness, background investigation, psychological evaluation, reading comprehension exam, physical exam and drug screening.

## **PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Extra consideration will be given to applicants who have:
  - Investigative experience.
  - Completed incident management training courses as prescribed by NIMS.
  - Participated in emergency response scenes, to include barricaded subjects, hostage situations, and active shooter scenes
  - A minimum of two years of experience in a proactive tactical unit such as Special Weapons and Tactics, Gang Unit, or a street crime unit.
  - Knowledge in the acquisition of equipment through DRMO, federal agencies, and grants will be given additional points when scoring of the candidates
