Overview:

The City of Leon Valley is recruiting nationally for a highly experienced professional to lead, inspire, and manage the initiatives and the day-to-day operations of the City Planning & Zoning Department.

The City has a notable suburban city design with a need for significant city planning and zoning expertise. The successful candidate will have a broad background in all aspects of city planning, urban design, land use, and revitalization.

Education:

A Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university with coursework in planning, urban design, Architecture, Construction Management, Geography, Public Administration, or a related field. Master's Degree in public administration, planning or urban design, or related field is highly desired. Certification in the American Institute of Certified Planner (AICP) is highly preferred. The City will also substitute for equivalent years of experience.

Experience:

Four (4) years of increasingly responsible urban planning, Municipal Planning, plan review, general city planning, zoning administration, or building code application experience to include three (3) years of supervisory or management experience is required.

City Planning & Zoning Director Salary: \$105,000 - \$120,000 annually

This position is eligible to receive merit based pay, on documented outstanding performance at the discretion of the City Manager.

Leon Valley's Next Planning and Zoning Director Will:

- Develop and sustain a strong team that is committed to exceptional service to the public, ongoing professional development and active professional involvement.
- Provide professional counsel and technical advice on matters related to planning, zoning, operation management, and policy program development of department functions.
- As the building official, this position is responsible for the effective administration of the development, building permit review processes, and retail food establishment inspection programs
- Work closely and collaboratively with City Council, City Planning and Zoning Commissions, Board of Adjustments, the City Manager, other city departments, businesses, residents, community advocates, developers and other investors.







Benefits:

The City Offers an attractive benefits package, the central provisions of which are as follows:

Retirement- The City of Leon Valley participates in the Texas Municipal Retirement System. The City deducts 7% of your gross compensation and matches that at a 2 to 1 ratio. Eligibility for retirement is 10 yrs. at age 60 or 20 yrs. at any age.

Flexible Schedule - Arrangement of a four-day workweek; accrual of Personal Leave and Major Medical.

Group Insurances - Health, dental and life insurances are covered at 100% for employee. Dependent care coverage is available at an affordable rate.
